- Council Recommendation of 22 May 2018 on promoting common values, inclusive education, and the European dimension of teaching,
- The Council Recommendation on Key Competences for Lifelong Learning,
- Policy framework of the ET2020 Working Group on Promoting Citizenship and the Common Values of Freedom, Tolerance and Non-Discrimination through Education.

## 2021-2027 programming

- Main goal: to increase participation of pupils with disabilities in mainstream education,
- Interventions build on the results of OP KED and SRSS projects.
- Support for local authorities, school directors, teachers and parents, changes in teacher education and training.
- Monitoring: a need for more specific indicators,
- No investments in special schools only for the activities aiming to transition to mainstream schools.
